Mastering Fundraising Practices

In the current challenging context of shrinking funding opportunities and a high number of competitors struggling for resources, only state-of-theart funding initiatives can successfully fund development, social impacts and humanitarian programmes. The design and execution of such initiatives require a deep and comprehensive understanding of donors' expectations, a set of technical skills in strategic planning, and the execution of a fundraising strategy.

Decoding Internet and AI Governance

As Artificial Intelligence (AI) technologies become increasingly integrated into different sectors of society, the need for robust governance mechanisms becomes paramount. While multistakeholder governance of the Internet brought together diverse actors to manage the Internet's resources, rulebook, and technical standards, Al governance represents a radically different evolution in a dramatically different geopolitical context. 

Sharpen your International Negotiation Skills


